A warming, medium to full bodied wine that seriously over delivers. From sunny inland Southern Portugal, this is fruit forward satisfying and vibrant 75% Aragones/15% Syrah/10% Tempranillo		
14. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Fantini Farnese, Abruzzo, Italy		£22.00
Deep purple in colour, this medium bodied wine from Italy's Adriatic Coast is clean and smooth, With spicy aromas . 100% Montepulciano		
15. Malbec, "Amalaya", Salta, Argentina		£23.00
This remarkable, complex yet quaffable wine is grown at 1800 metres altitude in the Andes, where the strong sun and low night temperatures ensure full development of the grapes. Mouthfilling smooth fruit. 85% Malbec, 10% Tannat, 5% Petit Verdot		
16. Shiraz, "Jester", Frank Mitolo, McLaren Vale, Australia		£23.50
McLaren Vale is home to some of the most typical powerful red wines in Australia and this Shiraz is a fine example. Fruit forward, yet quite complex. 100% Shiraz		
17. Valpolicella, Allegrini, Veneto, Italy		£24.00
Modern Valpolicella is very far removed from the substandard offerings of earlier years and this is excellent, with sweet dark cherry on the palate and a lingering delicate finish. 70% Corvina/30% Rondinella		
18. Pinot Noir, Plantagenet Three Lions, Mount Barker, Western Australia		£24.50
Very good version of Pinot Noir, combining the smoothness and fruit expected of the New World with the backbone and structure of Burgundy. Light to medium weight and very drinkable . 100% Pinot Noir		
19. Rioja Reserva, "Coto de Imaz", Rioja Alavesa, Spain		£26.50
Smooth and subtle, lovely mouthfeel. Warming palate, very gentle use of oak. A really good modern style Rioja reserva 100% Tempranillo		
20. Cabernet Franc, bodega Garzon reserve, Maldonado, Uruguay		£27.50
Medium weight, ripe and aromatic. Excellent wine from one of the leading producers in a lesser known part of South America. Soft fruit and herbs on the palate, mellow finish. 100% Cabernet Franc
